- Rope inspection services are available for used equipment. Experienced technicians closely inspect every inch of the rope, to ensure it's safe for continued use. In some cases, damaged rope can be cut down and repurposed into shorter lengths, safe for continued use.
- Hi-Line's fully stocked warehouse contains all the components required to assemble and repair rope sets, leading to a quick and cost-effective turnaround.



Custom New and Inspection / Repurposing of Used

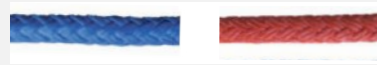
- **Winch Lines:** High-tenacity polyester rope, parallel braid-over-braid construction, with polyester core. Low stretch and high strength, with low ultraviolet degradation. Prolong life by adding nylon wear sleeves, bronze eye thimbles, and winch line hooks with protective spools and shields.
- **Rope Slings:** High strength and low-stretch rope, typically constructed with Esterplex. Nylon chafe and lift collars recommended to avoid compromising wear.
- **Hand Line Sets:** Three-strand, high-power rope is typically used for hand line sets up to 150 feet long. Polyester jackets provide abrasion and ultraviolet resistance. Sets that are 150 feet or longer use a 12-strand, single-braid, high-tenacity polyester rope, such as Esterplex, to reduce twist and torque while in use.
